Training for Cath Lab Staff and Interventional Cardiology Nurses

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This exciting lecture based program is designed for nurses and technologists interested in a career in the Cardiac Cath Lab, or staff newly employed in the Cath Lab. In addition, the program will benefit:

- 1) Diagnostic Cath Lab staff who are transitioning to Interventional Cath Lab setting and
- 2) Telemetry and Critical Care Nurses who care for the patient undergoing coronary and peripheral intervention.

Topics include:

- ♥ Cardiovascular anatomy and physiology (utilizing heart dissection), hemodynamics, cardiovascular disease processes
- ♥ Pharmacology, coronary diagnostic and therapeutic procedures: indications, techniques and complications
- ♥ Hemostasis and vascular closure devices
- ♥ Coronary and endovascular interventional procedures: indications, techniques and complications
- ♥ Emerging technologies
- ♥ Complications and emergencies, case studies

COURSE OBJECTIVES

- Identify ECG changes with ischemia, injury, and infarct
- Identify methods for maintaining patient comfort, privacy, and safety during procedures
- Discuss pharmaceutical therapy for the common CV diseases, including application of their hemodynamic action
- Describe potential cath lab interventions for various mechanical complications of acute myocardial infarction
- Demonstrate knowledge of standard views for coronary angiography and ventriculography
- Understand your role during a cath lab resuscitation
