

Basic Hemodynamics 2022 Course Information

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course is intended for nurses who are either unfamiliar or need a review of the fundamental concepts of Basic Hemodynamics. Vasoactive drugs will be covered. Topics include:

- Assessment and intervention using hemodynamic parameters measured from pulmonary artery (swan)
- Triple lumen, and
- Arterial monitoring systems

Monitoring system setup and maintenance, waveform analysis, pressure, SVR, CO value interpretation, SVO₂, and continuous cardiac output monitoring will also be included.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this course, the participant will be able to:

- Describe the physiologic determinants of cardiac output, arterial pressure, and oxygen delivery
- Determine accurate balance and zeroing of a PA catheter
- Apply pulmonary artery measurements to clinical settings
- Discuss the accuracy of hemodynamic data in patients on the following modes of ventilation: SIMV, AC, and PEEP, spontaneous
- Describe the hemodynamic effects of the following medications:

Amiodarone	Dobutamine
Lidocaine	Milrinone
Digoxin	Capoten
Nitroglycerine	Norepinephrine
Nitroprusside	Epinephrine
Dopamine	Neosynephrine
- Describe several troubleshooting methods for PA catheter tracings
