

Perioperative Best Practices & Procedures Workshop 2021 Information

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This 1-day Perioperative Best Practices and Procedures Workshop is designed primarily for RN's and techs within the specialty areas of Cath Lab and Labor and Delivery to prepare learners with cognitive knowledge, affective behavior skills, and the interactive, hands-on education necessary to work in a surgical perioperative environment. Upon completion of the one-day course, students will be able to demonstrate competency by applying the theory of aseptic technique within a simulated environment.

COURSE OBJECTIVES:

By providing instruction within our High-Fidelity Patient Simulation Center, students will be able to demonstrate an understanding of the following surgical techniques:

- Understand the perioperative environment, equipment, and the required usage documentation
- Adherence to principles of surgical attire and traffic patterns
- Apply sterile techniques to create sterile fields and maintain sterility of the field during procedures
- Understand the principles and practice for fire safety in a procedural area
- Understanding the principles and practice for prevention of retained surgical items
- Understand the responsibilities when handling tissue implants
